





One-cable Dual Monitors Set-up Instructions

Windows system: driver installation + display operation settings (6 steps in total)




- 1 The driver will be automatically installed when the tri-screen is connected to your laptop. Please ensure that your laptop is connected to the internet. After successful installation, restart the laptop to use it.
- 2 If your laptop can not install driver automatically, please insert the U flash disk and double-click "DRIVERS" with the left mouse button, and select the driver to install according to the current laptop system.
- 3 Double-click the "RacerDisplayDriver" application with the left mouse button to install it.




- 4 Click "Next" until the installation is complete (the laptop must be restarted after the installation is complete).
- 5 Right-click on the main interface of the laptop and select "Display Settings".
- 6 Select "Extend the Desktops of Display 1 and 3" in the screen settings (the position of displays 1,2,3 on the screen can be moved by the mouse).



Macbook: driver installation + display settings



- 1 After turning on the laptop, insert the U flash disk, and double-click "DRIVERS" with the left mouse button.
- 2 Open the Mac OS folder and double-click the "RacerUSB" file to install it.
- 3 Click "Next" to enter the laptop password and wait for the installation to complete.



- 4 Click the "Apple" icon on the upper left and select "System Preferences".
- 5 Select "Security & Privacy".
- 6 Select "Screen Recording" in Privacy.



- 7 Enable the recording permission of UsbDisplay. After successful installation, restart the laptop.
- 8 Return to the previous interface, and select "Displays".
- 9 For the detected monitor, set the "Extended display" for "Use as".
